Final Dispersal List – June 2018 Where did it all go?



Since announcing the closure of the site last summer following the final open day in October 2017 the Electric Railway Museum has embarked on a operation to find good homes for all the items in its collection. Not only the EMUs and Locomotives but wagons and heritage buildings. The operation was considered highly ambitious and some doubted it could be achieved in the timescale available. The last railed items left the site on June the 14th and with the exception of some final mopping up of track and buildings the process is complete. This has been quite possibly the greatest rescue ever undertaken in the UK heritage railway movement.
